

Typical cruise itinerary

Day 1 Porto Boarding from 17:00 to 19:00

Day 2 Porto / Caldas de Aregos Guided tour to Porto, the birthplace of Porto, with wine tasting in a cellar. Trip to Caldas de Aregos

Day 3 Caldas de Aregos / Pinhão Guided tour to the village of Pinhão with visit to the famous Railway Station with its beautiful, tiled panels Visit to a Douro Wine Estate with lunch included Tour to the magnificent baroque Palácio de Mateus in Vila Real with its beautiful gardens.

Day 4 Pinhão / Barca d'Alva / Vega Terrón Tour to Castelo Rodrigo, one of Portugal's historical parishes, with its castle ruins full of history.

Day 5 Barca d'Alva / Vega Terrón / Pocinho Day trip to the Spanish university city of Salamanca with its impressive cathedral and Plaza Mayor with lunch included (optional tour – booking on board only possible)

Day 6 Pocinho / Régua Tour to the pilgrimage town of Lamego with its impressive 'Stairway to Heaven' and gothic cathedral.

Day 7 Régua / Porto Tour to the "Birthplace of the Portuguese Nation" Guimarães" (optional tour – booking on board only possible)

Day 8 Porto 9:00 – Disembark at Vila Nova de Gaia Quay

4 Day/3 Night Portugal itinerary

Day 1 Lisbon - Évora

Depart Lisbon and arrive at the whitewashed town of Évora, a World Heritage site of UNESCO. Walk the narrow streets visiting the Romanesque-gothic Cathedral, Saint Francis Church with the Bones Chapel, and the University. Pass by the market and see local produce as well as local handicraft.

Day 2 Évora - Beja - Silves - Lagos

Morning at leisure in Évora, before heading southward to Beja, where the highest tower of Portuguese Medieval castles dominates the town and the region. Crossing small mountains, enter the Algarve, passing fields of orange trees. Arrive at Silves, the town dominated by its red sandstone castle dating back mainly to Moorish times. Pass by Praia da Rocha on the way to Lagos. (B)

Day 3 Lagos - Ponta da Piedade - Sagres - Cabo Sao Vincente - Lagos

Depart for Ponta da Piedade and admire the magnificent view and the cliffs whose shapes have been sculpted by the erosive action of both the sea and time. Continue to the fishing port of Sagres and visit the fortress. Stop at the cliffs of Cabo São Vincente, the most western point in Europe. Return to the cosmopolitan fishing port town of Lagos. Rest of the afternoon at leisure. (B)

Day 4 Lagos - Setubal - Lisbon

Depart for Setubal, a major port and industrial centre. Continue over the Arrabida Mountain range before returning to Lisbon. End of tour. (B)
